
Electronic Submission of records — ITA review

Injury Tracking Application (ITA) Information

Notice: Injury and illness data submission begins January 2, 2024. Visit the <u>ITA Coverage Application</u> to determine whether you are required to submit this data.

This page provides requirements and guidance about electronically submitting your establishments' injury and illness data from the OSHA Form 300A: Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses, OSHA Form 300: Log of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses, and OSHA Form 301: Injury and Illness Incident Report. OSHA provides a secure website, the Injury Tracking Application (ITA), where you can manually enter your data to the ITA via the web form, upload a CSV file to the ITA, or transmit data electronically via an API (application programming interface).

Electronic Submission of records – ITA review

- ITA coverage is determined by size of establishment and NAICS*.
- Peak number of employees, previous CY
- Covered employers must submit OSHA RK information annually.
- Submit from Jan. 2 to March 2.
- Even if late, employers are required to submit ITA – access is open until Dec 31







Electronic Submission of records – ITA review

- If exempt from RK, then no ITA requirements.
- Not everyone who has to keep OSHA logs has to do ITA electronic submission.
- Not everyone has to submit the same RK form: 300A, 300 and 301
- Use <u>ITA Coverage App</u> to find out






ITA Coverage App

Covered establishments must electronically submit their OSHA injury and illness data (Forms 300A, 300, and 301 data) by March 2 of the year following the covered year of the data (e.g., for submission of calendar year 2024 data that is March 2, 2025). However, not all establishments need to submit these data. To determine if your establishment is required to electronically submit data to OSHA, please complete the following selections. All selections are required.



Electronic Submission of records – ITA https://www.osha.gov/injuryreporting/

- Employers need an ITA account.
- Will get an email confirming submission.
- CSV upload: Employers get a confirmation email when submission was received and a second email to indicate success/failure.
- You can view your submitted data.
- You can update/edit submitted data (for CY2024).
- Anyone can check <u>OSHA's public</u> <u>database</u>. CY2024 will be posted starting after March 2.
