Do Not Use These Terms:

"OSHA approved"

OSHA does not "approve" trainers or classes/courses.

"Certified"

The OSHA Outreach Training Program is not a certification program and cannot be advertised as such.

"Compliant" or "Ensures compliance"

Only the customer can ensure that his or her workforce understands its site-specific requirements.

You May Use These Terms:

"OSHA authorized"

You may indicate that UL has received OSHA authorization to provide 10 and 30 hour outreach training.

"Conform"

UL's outreach training has been designed to conform to all federal OSHA requirements for online outreach training.

OSHA Program Overview:

- Available to U.S.-based employees under OSHA's jurisdiction
- Six months permitted to complete the training
- 24/7 access to OSHA course material
- Printable job aides available with each session
- Access to safety training and support professionals
- Printable diploma immediately available upon successful completion
- OSHA card provided by the U.S. Department of Labor
- Ability to earn IACET-approved CEUs: 1.0 (10-hour course) and 3.0 (30-hour course)
